- Lead on the development and implementation of a Regular Giving programme, ensuring excellent donor care and identifying opportunities for acquisition, upgrade and reactivation campaigns.
- Create and manage print and digital (email and social) donor journey and tailored communications to improve donor retention, repeat gifting and income KPI's.
- Develop and manage newly emerging legacy giving programme, championing and embedding legacy within the organisation.
